(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow works to be carried out to install apparatus, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Hampstead Lane, Nettlestead.

A closure is planned from 27th June 2022, with estimated completion by 30th June 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00730623470-05 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Hampstead Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of The Orchard, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The 7.5 tonne weight restriction on Gravelly Ways, Laddingford will be temporarily suspended, to allow for diverted traffic.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while works to install apparatus are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Hampstead Lane, Maidstone Road, Maidstone Road Roundabout, Hale Street By Pass, Hale Street, Branbridges Road, Branbridges Ind Est Roundabout, Beltring Road, Gravelly Ways, Lees Road and vice versa.
