Hampstead Lane, Yalding
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2022

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Hampstead Lane, Yalding.

A closure is planned from 26th August 2022 at 09:30, with estimated completion by 26th August 2022 at 15:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SEPOL000196616ONSA1-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Hampstead Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of Hampstead Lock, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Hampstead Lane, Maidstone Road, Hale Street By Pass, Branbridges Ind Est Roundabout, Branbridges Road, Beltring Road, Gravelly Ways, Lees Road and vice versa.
