(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2023

To allow level crossing maintenance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Hampstead Lane, Nettlestead.

A closure is planned from 23.30 hours on 15th June 2023, with estimated completion by 05.00 hours on 16th June 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL870PWS1-38-14-140623-01 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Hampstead Lane will be closed in the vicinity of the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while level crossing maintenance works are undertaken by Centurion Traffic Management.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2015 Maidstone Road, A228 Boyle Way, A228 Branbridges Road, Beltring Road, Gravelly Ways, Lees Road and vice versa.
