Internet Scams

We have been alerted by KCC that Kent residents have been targeted by fraudsters impersonating Virgin.

The fraudsters claim there is a problem with your internet speed and that they will cut your connection off unless you log into a specific website.

It is all a SCAM. They will either attempt to take over your system or steal your personal/financial data.

Virgin or any other internet provider will never contact you like this and will never ask you to download software for them to access your system.
