## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2023**

To allow level crossing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bow Bridge, Wateringbury.

A closure is planned from 9th May 2023, for up to one night, between the hours of 23.15 and 04.45, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL870PWS1-39-72-090523-01 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <a href="One.Network">One.Network</a>

Bow Bridge will be closed in the vicinity of the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while level crossing works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Bow Hill, A26 Tonbridge Road, Teston Lane, Smiths Hill, Kenward Road and vice versa.
