## **Bow Bridge, Wateringbury**

## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2021**

To allow level crossing maintenance works and other associated works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bow Bridge, Wateringbury.

A closure is planned from 26th February 2022 at 23:00, with estimated completion by 28th February 2022 at 08:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL870PWS1-39-72-260222-02 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <a href="One.Network">One.Network</a>

Bow Bridge will be closed in the general vicinity of the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while level crossing maintenance works and other associated works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.

The road will also be closed to pedestrians. However, a taxi service will be available on site to escort pedestrians, due to there not being an alternative route.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Bow Road, A26 Tonbridge Road, B2163 Teston Lane, Lower Road, B2010 Smiths Hill, Yalding Hill, Kenward Road, Bow Hill and vice versa.
