

Notice of the intention to make an Order to
temporarily close Public Footpath KM198
in the Parish of Yalding

(Public Footpath KM198)

(Prohibition Of Traffic) Temporary Order 2024

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Section 14(1), As Amended
By The Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

Kent County Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to temporarily close Public Footpath KM198 between its junction with Hampstead Lane and its junction with public footpaths KM197 and KM329 at Stoneham Lock from the 01 February 2024.

The path will be closed for a maximum of six months, although it is expected that it will reopen by the 30 May 2024.

The path is to be closed because the footbridge at Twyford Marina is being replaced by the Environment Agency.

There is no off road, traffic-free alternative route but there is a largely on-road alternative via footpath KM329, Gravelly Ways, Lees Road and Public Footpath KM199, but caution should be exercised using this route due to traffic.
