B2162 Hampstead Lane, Nettlestead

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & PEDESTRIANS) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2022

To allow level crossing maintenance and other associated works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic and pedestrians on part of B2162 Hampstead Lane, Nettlestead.

A closure is planned from 10th March 2022 at 23:30, with estimated completion by 11th March 2022 at 04:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL870PWS1-38-14-100322-01 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

B2162 Hampstead Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The weight restriction Order on Gravelly Ways will be temporarily suspended, to allow for diverted traffic.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while level crossing maintenance works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2015 Maidstone Road, A228 Hale Street By Pass, Branbridges Road, Beltring Road, Gravelly Ways, Leeds Road and vice versa.

A taxi service will be provided on site for pedestrians, due to there being no alternative route.
