Hampstead Lane, Yalding

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2022

To allow sluice works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Hampstead Lane, Yalding.

A closure is planned from 21st February 2022, with estimated completion by 31st March 2022. The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Hampstead Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of Hampstead Lane Bridge, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The 7.5 tonne weight limit Order on Gravelly Ways will be temporarily suspended, to allow for diverted traffic.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while sluice works are undertaken by Environment Agency.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Lees Road, Gravelly Ways, Beltring Road, A228 Branbridges Road, Hale-Street By-pass, B2015 Maidstone Road, Hampstead Lane and vice versa.
